Re: Medication and Needle Lock-Up

In accordance with NYS DOH Part 800.23 (f) all medications and needles must be secured when not in use. Only authorized persons should have access.

In addition, agencies that have both ALS and BLS technicians are required to have separate locked cabinets for both levels. At no time should BLS technicians have access to ALS gear/medications.
