



Advisory 22-08: Access to Collaborative Protocols

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The Collaborative Protocol App is no longer supported nor updated and therefore contains outdated sets of clinical care protocols. It is strongly recommended that the app be removed from devices else practitioners may unknowingly follow outdated or incorrect clinical care guidance.

The most recent version of the Collaborative BLS and ALS Protocols under which MLREMS agencies operate may be found on the Bureau of EMS Website at <https://www.health.ny.gov/professionals/ems/protocol.htm> and click on the “Collaborative Advanced Life Support Adult and Pediatric Treatment Protocols” to be sure you are viewing the most up-do-date version. The PDF can be downloaded to be viewed on devices.

The only App that is assured of receiving protocol updates is Muru, also linked through the Bureau of EMS Website.

We anticipate the next set of updates to the protocols being released around the first of the year, however protocol updates are released by the State directly through the website or app itself, unlike in the past when changes were released by notifications through the Program Agencies. This office will do its best to update practitioners with changes that we are aware of.
