EMT#2 Cuts or removes chin strap.	1		
EMT#2 supports occipital and mandible	1		
EMT#1 laterally spreads and removes helmet.	1		
EMT#1 takes over in-line immobilization after helmet is removed.	1		
EMT#2 measures c-collar and places on patient.	1		
EMT#2 reassesses motor, sensory and distal circulation	1
