



18-09 Changes in MLREMS Preceptor Credentialing

To: All EMS Agencies and Providers

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Date: November 5, 2018

At the request of the MLREMS Training Committee and Monroe Community College, the Division of Prehospital Medicine recently updated the regional preceptor training. The new format incorporates an on-line module available to all providers in the Cypherworx LMS as a prerequisite to a more concise workshop session based on the previous classroom course. Both components are required to complete the MLREMS credentialing process.

Moving forward, the live workshops will be offered by the Division of Prehospital Medicine in March and again in September of each year. The number of individual classes offered will be based on the number of providers who have completed the on-line module in the previous 6 month period of time. There will be no less than one class offered each spring and fall. This predictability should allow agencies and those interested in becoming preceptors a more reliable means of planning.

The requirements for both ALS and BLS preceptors remain unchanged. Those requirements are outlined in their respective policies. The complete policies for both the ALS and BLS Preceptor Policies can be located on the MLREMS website, or by following these links:
