1. Collaborative Protocol update - training
  - a. Ben - The BLS updates for the Collaborative Protocols are being rolled out, by the state, through Cypherworx. New York State contracted with the same vendor (Cypherworx) that DPM uses, however, the Collaborative Protocols updates are through New York State's page within the site. DPM has pushed out resources to aid providers with navigation on the site and the MLREMS page has useful instructions. All providers have to take the SHORT version and complete the MLREMS affirmation prior to December 31 (LONG version if they never took the original Collaborative Protocols rollout).
2. Local Collaborative Protocols exam
  - a. Eric - Is there a desire/use for a Collaborative Protocol exam within the region? The ALS Preceptor Policy requires applicants score 85% or higher on a protocol exam BUT there isn't an up-to-date exam. Mike and Eric are working on one. Basically, choice is have DPM complete a local exam available for use regionally OR submit change to preceptor policy.
  - b. Ben - what is the use/gain of having the exam?
  - c. Eric - probably familiarization with protocols.
  - d. Linda - likes the requirement because it is a good screening tool for potential preceptors.
  - e. Sal - Important for preceptors to demonstrate good protocol knowledge.
  - f. Since nobody was in favor of altering preceptor policy and some spoke for the value of the exam, will recommend to DPM that exam be created and maintained.
3. AMR Preceptor Course Waiver
  - a. Eric - Reviewed by Mike, Ben, and Eric (no one else expressed desire to be on ad hoc committee for review). Materials and implementation at AMR are robust, lengthy (6-8 hours), and meet or exceed the minimum expectations and objectives of the in-person portion of the MLREMS Preceptor Course. Will submit a motion at Council to provide AMR a waiver.

  - a. Ben will work on scheduling.
