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Some law enforcement agencies locally are beginning to phase in the use of the Axon TASER 7. 
The Axon TASER 7 projectile is larger in size as the conduction wire is stored inside and unspools as it travels. The barb itself is nearly identical. See image to the right: Top is the Taser X2 versus Taser 7 below (Courtesy of http://wdforensic.com/the-axon-taser-7/).

The new probe can be removed in a similar fashion as the old probe and as outlined in Regional Policy. New to the TASER 7 is a probe remover which is built in to the cartridge safety clip. This can be used to securely



remove the barb from the skin. Detailed instructions can be found at https://help.axon.com/hc/en-us/articles/360011032994-Probe-Removal-and-Handling-Used-Probes: the cartridge safety clip is yellow and can be used to safely remove the device in the fashion identified in the images below.
