See attached letter and documentation from the state. Specifically, attention should be paid to page 1 (letter) and the bottom of PDF page 11 (document page number 7) where it specifies the three options T&E has in their recommendation to the full committee. 2. Henrietta's application was approved unanimously in the May 2015 MLREMS meeting but was kicked back by the state because it didn't go through T&E prior to going to MLREMS. 3. Discussion amongst attendees focused on the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Linda – Henrietta wishes to teach a BLS core content, ALS core content, and sometime in the future an EMT original class annually. b. Linda - currently HVA teaches the core content classes already but CICs cannot use these classes towards their recertification because there isn't a state course number assigned. c. Linda - geographic need exists in southern Monroe Co (Rush, Scottsville, Henrietta) and northern Livingston County for an EMT original class. d. Aaron – concern about removing students from current course sponsors since even losing a few students could be harmful. e. Nicole – not in attendance but passed information along through Eric that | | |

Ben – impact statements were sent to current course sponsors by the state, program agency is not privy to that data. He can try to request the results of these surveys. g. Eric – would like to see data on other regions and the course sponsors/population. h. Sharon – are there students whose needs are not being met? Is it possible for a relationship like she had with Monroe where she contracted with Monroe which allowed her to teach a class at UR? i. Aaron – believes consolidation not further expansion of training centers is needed. Terry agrees. j. Aaron/Terry – not comfortable making this decision in haste without data. <p>4.
